J. B. MILLER VIOLIN

This beautiful violin was made by master craftsman J. B. Miller, the #1 inductee into the Georgetown and Scott County Museum String Instrument Maker's Hall of Fame and belongs to William Bauer. Several years ago, Mr. Bauer and his fellow Louisville Philharmonic orchestra members compared this violin with three "pedigreed" examples: J. B. Guadagnini, Carlo Testore, and Ceruti. The orchestra declared Miller and Guadagnini violins totally superior, equal in projection and clarity.

Said Bauer, "I know my new violin is worth more than all these combined because it has the richness of nature in its woods, the gold of the sun in its incomparable varnish, and the heart of the master craftsman in its voice."
